

## Student Information Requested on the Online Application

---

A local P.E.O. chapter must recommend a high school senior before she may become an applicant for the P.E.O. STAR Scholarship. Once a chapter has recommended a student, she will be emailed a link to begin the online application process. The dates for chapters to make online recommendations are September 1 through November 1. The recommended applicant will then have 30 days to complete the online application after receiving the link.

What information is requested on the student's online application?

**Basic Information:** The applicant provides name, contact information, birthdate, citizenship information, unweighted GPA, class rank (if available), name and address of high school, names and titles of two people who the applicant will ask to write letters of reference (instructions are included for the applicant to request letters of reference). The applicant is asked to grant permission to the P.E.O. Sisterhood to use her name and information for publicity purposes if selected as a recipient. If the applicant is under 18 years of age, a parent or guardian must sign the application (instructions are included on how to do this).

The applicant is asked to submit an unofficial (or official)

transcript through the 11th grade (junior year) online with the online application. Canadian applicants must include a copy of their Province Conversion Grading Scale.

**Activity Charts:** The applicant is asked to complete two Activity Charts online, one for her Extracurricular Activities and one for her Community/Volunteer Service. Both charts have spaces to include activities, activity years, positions and involvement, and leadership and skills acquired. Describe and explain the activities. Instructions are included with the online application.

**Essay:** The applicant writes an essay online articulating and discussing her (potential) higher education and career goals. Instructions are included with the online application.
