Amendments Adopted

Following are summaries of the amendments to the Constitution, Bylaws, and Standing Rules which were adopted at the 2003 Convention of International Chapter of the P.E.O. Sisterhood. All adopted amendments must be implemented immediately.

Amendment to Part I, Article VII and Part II, Article VIII

- Allows the incoming board to act on appointments before installation.

Amendment to Part I

- Article VI—Allows the executive board to hold meetings by teleconference or videoconference.

Amendments to Part II

- Article VI—Removes the provision for nominations for state officers when there is no nominating committee.
- Article VII—Allows meetings of the executive board to be held by teleconference or videoconference.

Amendments to Part III

- Article II—Removes the requirement for a member to request her name be placed on the nonresident list.
- Article III—Clarifies the fact that the local chapter determines when to schedule its meetings.
- Article V—Directs the local chapter treasurer to issue receipts only for cash received or upon request.

Amendment to the Bylaws

- Article VIII—Allows technological transmission of supplies by the P.E.O. Supply Department.



Amendment to the Standing Rules

- Adds a process for amending the Standing Rules of International Chapter and the provision that notice of the proposed amendment(s) be published in THE P.E.O. RECORD.

Implementing Amendments to the Ceremony of Initiation and Procedure for P.E.O. Chapter Meeting

Certain amendments adopted at the 2003 Convention of International Chapter will necessitate changes in the Ceremony of Initiation and the Procedure for P.E.O. Chapter Meeting. No changes should be made in the Ceremony or the President's Book until each local chapter receives written directions from International Chapter.

P.E.O. Video Available

The recently updated P.E.O. video "Women Helping Women through Education" is now available for purchase. This is the same video that was shown on Projects Night at the Convention of International Chapter in Oklahoma City. Narrated by a P.E.O. and her B.I.L., the video gives a brief overview of each of the five International projects, and then takes the viewer on a tour of the headquarters buildings in Des Moines, Iowa.
