AHI Connects | Music in Doolin.

Doolin is synonymous with music because of the number of musicians who live in the area. Be welcomed into a musician's home for a session of traditional songs, musical lore and a glass of wine.

Ennis Walking Tour. Enjoy a stroll through Ennis' winding streets to uncover a city steeped in legend, folklore, and mythology. Your entertaining guide will share tales of intrigue and lore that reveal the unique history and charm of Ennis.

Irish Music & Dance. Tap your feet to the lively beat as a traditional céilí band and champion dancers entertain you with an exclusive performance of traditional songs and famous melodic airs.

The Cliffs of Moher. Marvel at the striated limestone cliffs rising 700 feet above the Atlantic. The Cliffs of Moher are recognized as one of the world's most unique landscapes, with a dramatic coastline of rugged beauty stretching more than five miles. You may see Atlantic puffins during your visit.

Aran Island of Inishmore. Ferry across Galway Bay to this beautiful island, where Gaelic is the first language. As you explore, your local guide shares stories about island life. See Dun Aengus, the most famous of the Aran Islands' Bronze Age stone forts.

Killarney National Park. Ride through beautiful landscapes of flora and fauna on a traditional Irish horse-drawn carriage, known as a "Jaunting Car." Your driver shares tales and lore of the area during the ride. Next, board a boat to cruise through the scenic Lakes of Killarney.

Ring of Kerry. Soak up the spectacular Ring of Kerry and admire unique vistas at every turn. Meet a local shepherd who demonstrates how he moves sheep around the land with his loyal collies. After lunch, drive through the scenic Irish towns.

Whiskey Tasting. Delight in a whiskey tasting paired with tasty appetizers while learning about Irish whiskey production.

Dingle Peninsula. Take a ferry from Killimer to Tarbert. Visit the Blasket Island Heritage Center, which honors the people who lived on the Blasket Islands until the mid-1900s.

Exploring Dublin. There is much to see in this thriving capital city that is filled with history and charm. Discover the sites of bustling Dublin on a guided tour. Visit historic Trinity College and see the famous hand-illuminated Book of Kells.

Dublin Gastronomy. Dublin is a great destination for food lovers. Savor traditional Irish flavors on a culinary walking tour and taste local finger foods during your excursion.
